NSPMP Revises Prescribing Pad to a Duplicate Form March 2008

With all retail pharmacies now submitting prescriptions for monitored drugs through the NSPMP's on-line system, the Program is able to modify the prescribing pad to a duplicate format. The new pad will be virtually identical to the triplicate with minor changes in top and bottom text to reflect that there are only two copies. The transition to the new duplicate will be initiated as the stock of triplicates is depleted. It is anticipated that you will start to see the new pad in late April 2008.
