Dear Prescribers & Pharmacists:

During the last few weeks the Nova Scotia Prescription Monitoring Program (NSPMP) has noted an increase in stolen duplicate pads and has provided notification of this to all prescribers and pharmacists across the province. The NSPMP encourages pharmacists and prescribers to contact law enforcement with information regarding stolen duplicate pads or when stolen duplicate prescriptions are presented at the pharmacy.
