



Methadone Maintenance Treatment Patient Profile/Enrollment/Discharge Form

Per the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Nova Scotia Methadone Maintenance Treatment Handbook, a current patient profile must be obtained and patients must be enrolled in the NSPMP Methadone Program Monitoring Service. A current patient profile can be obtained either through the NSPMP eAccess web application or by contacting NSPMP directly. This service will provide the physician with a patient drug profile prior to initiating treatment. Also, NSPMP conducts weekly monitoring of patient profiles and advises physicians if the patient has obtained a monitored drug from other prescribers during the course of their treatment.

Methadone Program Monitoring will continue until such time as the NSPMP has received notification that a patient has been discharged from the methadone program. Physicians are required to provide timely notification of enrollment to and discharge from a methadone program.
